2010 Member Election Update and Ballot

- Vets Now Scotland Richard Dixon (Vets Now founder and president) attended a VSPA meeting a few years ago as a guest. Vets Now owns a number of emergency practices in the UK that operate during off hours in existing day practices. They completed construction and opened a large multi specialty hospital in 2009. This new practice it is fully qualified as a potential member. If elected they will be responsible for converting financials to US dollars. Their application, interview results and contact information will be posted to the list serve.
- Does any VSPA member have a fully qualified second locations? Discussion of when a second practice needs to apply for membership.
 - O General guidelines: If financial data is reported all together and the second practice is under the same tax ID# it does not need to apply.
 - o If an additional practice has a separate tax ID it needs to apply when fully qualified.
- MOON officially launched in April. A goal of the VSPA By-laws is to protect the Management Statement confidentiality and to prevent antitrust issues. The two current VSPA members that joined MOON will not be on the 2010 ballot as they are no longer eligible for VSPA membership.
- Leah read the list of six hospitals being recruited for membership. Mark Dorfman talked about the difficulty he has getting past the gate keepers and requested assistance with communicating the benefits and value of VSPA to prospective practice owners & administrators. Request for VSPA members to contact practices where individuals are known.
- 2010-2011 Membership Election Ballots to go out June 1st with a June 21st return date.
- The membership recruiting data base will be added to the VSPA website for members to contact desired practices and give the recruiting committee a better chance of connecting.

Residency Program Update

- The VSPA Facilitated Residency Program has not achieved sufficient member interest and will be
 placed on hold. The sponsors expressing interest in participation will be notified of this hold. The
 message is that VSPA did not want to solicit funds and support for a program that does not have
 full member support. Hills, Purina, Idexx, Webster and Pfizer will be contacted by board
 members.
- The current list of residents in VSPA hospitals will be added to the members' area of the VSPA website. The list will include which practice, what specialty and what year of residency.

Speakers Bureau Update

VSPA to provide facilitation support for VSPA speakers. A signup sheet was passed around at the business meeting for speakers wanting to be promoted by VSPA. All speakers will be given \$250/hr, of which they give VSPA 10% up to a maximum. VSPA does the work promoting, sourcing, pushing info out to conferences/VMA's, National, State and local meetings and sponsors etc. VSPA speakers will have a VSPA logo on their slide or use a Power Point template with the VSPA logo.

Proposed program details:

Why:

- To gain recognition of VSPA among veterinarians.
- To promote VSPA to industry.
- To support members in supplemental income.
- To contribute funds toward VSPA strategic goals.

How:

 Administrative Director (AD) to regularly contact agenda committees (AAHA, AVMA, Wild West, IVECCS, Vet schools, state associations etc.) for speaking opportunities, deadlines and submission requirements.

- AD to maintain a list of speakers, topics and preferred geographic areas.
- AD to provide above list to sponsors and agenda committees.
- AD to post opportunities to list serve.
- AD to assist members with submissions.
- AD to provide PPT template w/VSPA logo.

Income:

VSPA to collect 10% of honorarium up to a maximum from the VSPA member.

The full amount of honorarium is taxable income for the speaker. Pam will research the option of VSPA collecting the honorarium, paying the member and issuing 1099's. She will also research the possibility of the 10% being a gift to VSPA.

Pam will post a call for speakers on the list serve. In addition she will create a forum for VSPA practice staff members where they can participate in the Speakers Bureau and forum discussions at the staff level.

Distribution of Member Questions for Fall 2010 Meeting
